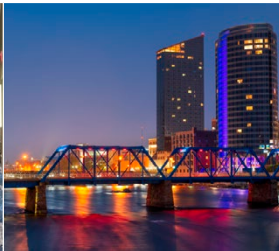

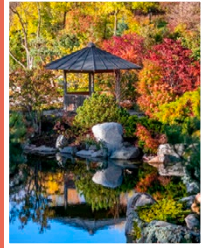

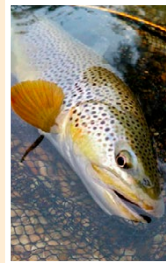
GOLF
